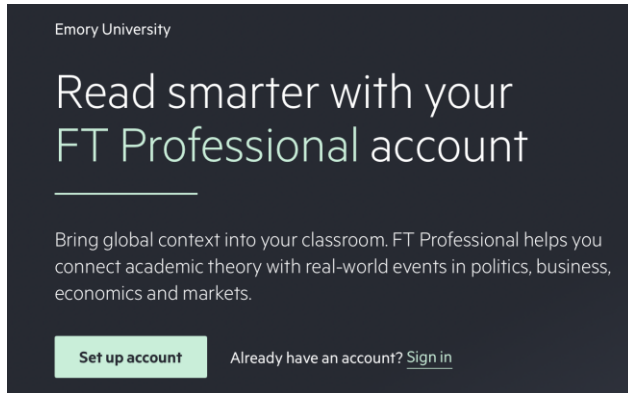



## Register for Access to Financial Times (FT.com)
