Candid

Previously known as Foundation Directory Online and GuideStar, Candid merges all of the content from the two databases.

With a focus on nonprofit and grants data, use Candid to:

- Identify and research nonprofits based on mission, programs, locations, and key decision makers
- Find historical and current grant and nonprofit data found in 990s
- Explore current financial overviews, trends and annual data

Filtered Searching

You can filter by mission, organizational characteristics, financial information, and grantmakers/grants.

This template allows you to customize your search by using fixed indexes.

You can combine filtered and keyword searching, but it is recommended that you begin with filtered searching. See below for *Tips for Combining Filtered and Keyword Searching*.

Start by clicking Filters to open the filtered search template.

Tips for Successful Filtered Searching

Start by browsing through all of the filters to understand the applied metatags. This will allow you to conduct the most successful, targeted searches.

- **Subject Area** – Use to identify industries/topics (e.g. agriculture, arts, education, health, philanthropy, sports, etc.)
- **Population Served** – Use to filter by targeted population (e.g. age groups, ethnic and racial groups, gender identify, health, social & economic status, etc.)
- **Geographic Area Served** – Use to identify geographic areas where grants are directed (e.g. country, state, region, city, MSA, etc.)
 - If you are looking for organizations/grants directed towards international causes, you might also use this strategy: Subject Area>International (e.g. international human rights, international development, international relations, etc.). You can also combine this filter with the Geographic Area Served filter

Tips for Combining Filtered and Keyword Searching

Begin your search using the filtered template. These are specifically tailored to target frequently searched subjects, populations, organizations, grants and financials used for gathering nonprofit data.

If you need to narrow your results using keywords that are not incorporated into the filtered vocabulary, you can enter keywords into the search box at the top of the page.

Search

- All typed keywords must appear in each record. For example: food pantry veterans will be interpreted as food AND pantry AND veterans, and each word must appear in a record
- Boolean logic is not recognized; you cannot include AND and OR. For example, this search would not be successful: (food pantry OR community kitchen) AND veterans
- Filtered searching yields higher priority, more relevant results. But keywords entered in the search box can appear *anywhere* in a record, possibly diluting the relevancy you are seeking
- The full text of 990s are not included in searches. Open a 990 and keyword search within the individual filing

Editing Filtered Searches

Click Dashboard in the upper right corner anytime you want to edit a current search or start a new search

Downloading Results

Excel

You can download records into an Excel spreadsheet. Select specific records or all records *per page*. Note: records are displayed in batches of 25/page; each spreadsheet can only reflect one page at a time.
