# Registering and using the Atlanta Business Chronicle

https://libraries.emory.edu/business/research-learning/databases/business-journals-book-lists-bol. Create an account using your Emory.edu email.

Once your account registration is complete, you can log directly into <a href="https://www.bizjournals.com/atlanta/">https://www.bizjournals.com/atlanta/</a> and sign in with your newly created email and password.

Our rep recommends logging in directly to the website rather than downloading the app for a better user experience. NOTE: Currently, the Business Chronicles are only licensed for GBS faculty, staff, and students.

#### **Chronicle Sections**

Links at top of the page

Latest News Lists & Leads Commercial Real Estate Banking Technology Health Care Residential Real Estate Atlanta Inno

- Most are the same across all the city chronicles, but there may be some variation depending on a city's dominant industries
  - Latest News
    - Click for quick links to the 18 industry verticals the Chronicles cover (these are the same for all cities)



- Clicking on Latest News displays a page with the most recent stores; on the left is a list of the 18 industries; click one to display the most recent stories for the industry
- Clicking on a specific industry will display subcategories at the top of the page

- For each industry, the related recent Lists and People on the Move stories will also display
- Recommend that you regularly look at the Commercial Real Estate Industry section; contains information relevant to multiple industries, companies, the economy, etc.

#### Lists & Leads

- The top 25 lists published weekly
- To search for specific lists
  - Scroll down a little for the lists search box
  - You can search by company name, person, etc. Searches the title of the list as well as any words contained within the list
  - Search tips: place phrases in quotes, e.g. "home depot," "gregory fenves"
  - Once you run a lists search, you can additionally filter by: date, company, industry, and people



#### **Public Record Leads**

- Locate timely information about real estate construction, new businesses, court records, and liens & bankruptcies
- You can also locate this information on the Chronicle Home page, about 2/3 down the page



#### Atlanta Inno

• Everything that is innovations focused, e.g. people, companies, etc.

#### **Additional Sections**

- BizSpotlight
  - o At the Chronicle home page, scroll down more than halfway to get to this section
    - This is positive company news/announcements that is generated by the company itself; is a form of advertising but can contain some useful information that doesn't appear in news articles

## **Book of Lists and Weekly Chronicle Issues**

- At the Chronicle Home page, on far right under Digital Edition
  - View this week's edition
    - Click to view the most recent weekly chronicle
    - Click Archives on the upper left to view previous editions going back 7 years
    - You can both view online and download/print the PDF
  - Book of Lists
    - Click to view the most recent Book of Lists
    - Click Archives on the upper left to view previous editions going back 12 years
    - You can only view online; you do not have the option to download/print to PDF
    - TIP: If you want to download/print a particular list from the BOL: 1) scroll down to the bottom
      of the list and the actual date it was printed in the Chronicle should be noted; go to the digital
      edition for that week's chronicle, then download/print the list in PDF


## **Keyword Searching and Filters**

- Use the search box at the top of the page by clicking on the search icon on the far right
- Keep searches as simple as you can
- Place phrases in quotes, e.g. "home depot," gregory fenves"
- You can use Boolean logic but keep it simple
  - Hire OR hiring
  - o Railroads AND "supply chain"
- When search results are returned, use the filters on the left to narrow down results by: Data Range, Companies, People, Industries; each category indicates the number of mentions of your keywords



### **Keeping Up with News**

- Creating Saved Searches/Alerts
  - This is not a current function
  - Instead, set up Newsletter Notifications
- Newsletter Notifications
  - To set up on the upper right corner, Member Account pull down the menu and click Newsletters
  - Select a City, then click Submit
  - All the Newsletters for that city will display; check the ones you want



- Morning Edition goes out 8am
- Afternoon Edition goes out 3pm
  - If you don't want to subscribe to both, select the Afternoon Edition as it includes all of the afternoon news and most of the morning news
  - o Includes "People on the Move" stories
- Breaking News
  - Hard-hitting news stories
  - People and Companies to Know goes out every Friday at 1pm with all news for the week (Mon-Fri)
    - People that have been promoted or newly hired; may also include people joining boards; is reported by their companies
    - Corresponds with the "People on the Move" section of the Chronicle
- Weekly Event Guide/Event Announcements
  - In each city the Chronicles host special events focused on scheduling networking events to bring the business community together in recognition of companies and individuals;
  - o These events include: company awards, C-level individual awards, and others
- Inno Beat
  - Focuses on innovation for companies, industry, people get once a week, recaps the week's Innovation stories

- Weekend Edition goes out each Sat am
  - o Includes the top 15 news stories/most read from the previous week (Mon-Fri)
  - There are no weekend "new" news stories
- Unsubscribing to Newsletters
  - o Click the Unsubscribe link at the bottom of the specific Newsletter email

## **Accessing via Mobile Devices**

The rep recommends not using the apps but rather going directly to the website (<a href="https://www.bizjournals.com/atlanta/">https://www.bizjournals.com/atlanta/</a>) and signing in with the username/password you created when you registered. This provides you with complete access and functionality.
