To browse an issue of the AJC daily newspaper

- From the Home Page, scroll down the page below the map, and click Today's Atlanta Journal Constitution
 Image Edition
- Coverage: 2017 today's issue
- Click on a specific issue date and the image of that day's newspaper will display
- You can browse the newspaper as if you had the print paper in hand
- You can also keyword search the issue; see Search for Articles below





Browsing Other Newspapers

- On the Home Page, click the A-Z Source List link in the upper left corner
- All Keywords, change menu to Source Name>search Atlanta
- All the newspapers will display
- Select the title(s) you want to browse



Once selected, your newspaper selection(s) will display




Refine By Source Location

 - You can search a specific date, a year, or a range of dates or years; formatting the dates is very flexible
 - 9/10/2022

 - 6/5/2022-7/15/2022

Keyword Searches


- You can search all or specific sections of the newspaper
 - Select a Field (optional)
 - Default searches the title, subject headings, first few paragraphs)
 - All Text
 - Lead Paragraph
 - Title
 - TIP article titles change, so recommend you search the Lead Paragraph for the keywords in the title rather than search the "exact" title
- Author/Byline

Search Functionality

- Truncation (strateg*)

- Each article includes a brief highlight of your keywords in context
- On the left
 - Sort by
 - Default is most recently published first

The slicer and grinder had excess accumulation of debris. With the closure of Allanta Medical Center growing ever nearer; DeKalb County could send \$8 million in additional funding to Grady Memoral Hospital – and \$12 million more to expand and improve services at proory Hill-andale Hospital.

DeKalb COO Michael Thurmond announced the proposal Tuestody morning, a day after Atlanta Medical Center started diverting ambulances to other facilities. Wellstar Health System plans to close the longtime downtown Allanta hospital by Nov. I, with the emergency department shuttering by Oct. 14.

The closing stands to strain nearby hospitals like Grady; Emory Midtown and Piedmont the most. But 20-30% of AMC's patients are generally DeKalb County residents, and Thurmond has vowed to do whatever's possible to help offset the impact. That includes his new proposal for Emory Hillandale, a hospital about 18 miles east of AMC in Stonecrest. The facility opened

Emory Healthcare interim CBO and president Dane Peterson and other representatives from the hospital system attended the vir-tual county commission meeting where Thurmond announced the proposal. They expressed sup-port for the idea. "Hillandale has outgrown its capacity," Dr. Bryce Gartland, Emory's hospital group presi-dent, said. DeKalb, meanwhile, already sends millions to Grady every

DeKalb, meanwhile, already sends millions to Grady every year. This year's regular contribution is scheduled to be \$22.2 million. The additional \$8 million proposed on Tuesday would help address the hospital's operating deficit, which was driven up by the high cost of using contract nurses during the pandemic. State officials have piedged \$130 million to help Grady expand its operations in the wake of AMC's closure. But that work is likely to take at least two years. Thurmond is hopeful an expunsion at Emory Hillandiae could provide shorter-term relief, hough as specific time frame was not available. Gartland said that, if approved, work to expand the emergency department in particular would begin as soon as possible. "I think we'll strengthen the


